Subject: The use of Engines & Thrusters while racing.

Add SI 15.3

15.3 USE OF ENGINES AND THRUSTERS

- (a) For safety reasons, engines or trusters may be engaged for propulsion at any time during the race for collision avoidance or to get clear after grounding.
- (b) A yacht that puts her engine into gear or uses her thruster for propulsion while racing, shall submit a written declaration of "engine use" to the race committee as soon as practicable after racing, stating the time the engine was in gear or thruster was used, the reason for use, the duration of use and any potential competitive advantage gained.
- (c) The race committee and protest committee will review all declarations on engine and thruster use to determine whether use was appropriate, and if a penalty shall be applied where there was competitive gain or significant advantage. [NP]

Notice of the Around the Island Race – 24th January, 2025



It is the intention of the race committee that an "Around the Island" Race (Courses 21 and 22) will be held on Friday 24th January 2025.

The schedule time of the first warning signal shall be 09:30 hrs for all classes except for boats nominated below:

All Club Class Boats VG Offshore (IRC 2) Trident (Multihull)

Nominated Boats are invited to make use of an "Early Start Procedure" as follows:



A Start line will be established in the position described in Attachment C. *Start Boat:* 06°14.7N - 099°53.4E between 07.45 – 08.45.

Nominated Boats may start at any time between 0745 to 0845 hrs. by passing through the line in the direction of Gate No. 1 and informing the race committee of their start time on Channel 71. This changes RRS 26

Any Nominated boats not starting within the 07:45 to 08:45 window, may start in the standard starting procedure, with the first warning signal at 09.30.
